#### Outline of Romans 9 - 11

### I Rom 9.1-5 Introduction – Paul suffers because so many Jews don't accept Jesus

1 "For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my own people, a my kindred according to the flesh" (Rom 9.3)

# II Rom 9.6-18 Promise not received by human ways or acts, rather by grace & promise

"8This means that it is not the children of the flesh who are the children of God, but the children of the promise are counted as descendants." (Rom 9.8)

### III Rom 9.19-29 God is sovereign; God chooses who God wants to choose, or not

- 1 "20 But who indeed are you, a human being, to argue with God? Will what is molded say to the one who molds it, "Why have you made me like this?" <sup>21</sup> Has the potter no right over the clay, to make out of the same lump one object for special use and another for ordinary use?" (Rom 9.20-21)
- 2 ""If the Lord of hosts had not left survivors to us, we would have fared like Sodom and been made like Gomorrah."" (Rom 9.29b)

## IV Rom 9.30 – 10.4 fulfilling Law by effort worthless; fulfilling law by Faith good

1 "4For Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes." (Rom 10.4)

### V Rom 10.5-21 Salvation comes not by doing law but by proclaiming faith

- "if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." (Rom 10.9)
- 2 "13 For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." (Rom 10.13)
- 3 "I have been found by those who did not seek me; I have shown myself to those who did not ask for me." (Rom 10.20b)

#### VI Rom 11.1-10 God Has Chosen that Not All of Israel Will Be Lost

- 1 "at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by grace." (Rom 11.5b)
- "Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened," (Rom 11.7b)

# VII Rom 11.11-24 Gentiles Grafted into Israel; Israel Will Be Regrafted In

- 1 "Branches were broken off so that (we Gentiles) might be grafted in." (Rom 11.19)
- 2 "23And even those of Israel, if they do not persist in unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again." (Rom 11.23)

### VIII Rom 11.25-32 All Israel Will Be Saved

- 1 "29 for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable." (Rom 11.29)
- 2 "32 For God has imprisoned all in disobedience so that he may be merciful to all." (Rom 11.32

# IX Rom 11.33-35 Concluding Hvmn

1 "33" O the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!" (Rom 11.33)
